Airport Concession Disadvantaged Business Enterprise (ACDBE) Program Overview

What is ACDBE Program?

- Established by the U.S. Congress
- Governed by federal regulation: 49 CFR 23
- For-profit small business concern:

To **Ensure Non-discrimination** in the award and administration of contracting and lease opportunities.

To create a **Level Playing Field** to encourage participation of small businesses in a contracting marketplace.

To **Support Economy** through small businesses.



Benefits of Certification



- Marketing Tool Certification is a marketing tool. Certified firms are listed in the applicable database(s), where they can be viewed by prime contractors, leaseholders and government entities.
- Reflects Diversity & Strengthens Capability Primes often add local and diverse businesses to their proposals and bids to strengthen their capabilities, create broader appeal, and better reflect local interests.
- Agency Commitment SFO encourages and is committed to the participation of certified small businesses throughout its programs.



ACDBE Eligibility Requirements



Presumed Socially Disadvantaged – Women, Black Americans, Hispanic Americans, Native Americans, Asian-Pacific Americans, & Subcontinent Asian Americans, Other (as designated by Small Business Administration (SBA), or individual showing); refer to 49 CFR 26, Appendix E.

Economically Disadvantaged – Personal Net Worth not exceeding **\$1.32 million** excluding equity in primary residence and applicant business.

Business Size Standards – A firm (including affiliates) must be a small business as defined by SBA standards. For most types of businesses, gross receipts averaged over the previous 3 years must not exceed:

ACDBEs – \$56.42 million

Ownership & Control – The firm must be at least **51% owned** by one or more and **controlled** by both socially and economically disadvantaged or, in the case corporation, in which 51% of the stock is owned by one or more such individual(s).

Independence – The 51% majority owner(s) must be free of any formal or informal restrictions that would affect their ability to own and/or control the firm.



ACDBE Certification Application Processing

- 1. Uniform Certification Application: <u>https://flysfo.gob2g.com/</u>
- 2. Click <u>Apply for / Renew</u> Certification button
 - Personal Net Worth Statement (PNW), must be notarized
- 3. Certification Specialist preliminary review: documentation
- 4. Within 30 days: notice if application is complete and suitable for evaluation
- 5. In-person / virtual site visit
- 6. Certification decision within 90 days
- 7. Certified firm will be added to the following directories:
 - 1. State database at https://californiaucp.dbesystem.com/
 - 2. Federal database at https://faa.dbesystem.com/Default.asp

Interstate Certification

- 1. Must be certified in the home state before seeking certification in another state.
- 2. Out-of-State Declaration: <u>https://flysfo.gob2g.com/</u>
- 3. Must submit a complete package of all the documents submitted to their home state
- 4. On-site report request from the home state
- 5. Certification decision within 60 days

What is an ACDBE? ... at SFO 49 CFR Parts 23



- Small businesses play an important role in making SFO exceptional. Small businesses are encouraged to compete on all applicable projects as primes, subcontractors, joint venture partners, and suppliers.
- SFO goals are race-neutral. We do not evaluate RFPs and bids based on proposed ACDBE participation though bidders and proposers on projects at SFO must list all certified firms they plan to do business with.
- SFO's federal fiscal three-year ACDBE participation goals is 15.6% for concession and 0.6% for car rental.
- SFO does extensive outreach and encourage the participation of ACDBEs.

If awarded a bid, and depending on the scope and scale of the goods and/or services being purchased, the procurement process generally consists of the following steps:

- Providing a signed W9
- Completing a Supplier Setup Form with information about your company
- Providing a copy of your ACDBE certification
- Signing a Master Goods/Services Agreement and applicable statement of work or price sheet
- Utilizing a purchase order for invoicing
- Meeting certain insurance requirements

(insurance requirements vary depending on the scope and scale of the goods/services)
